We will also create a Kilkenny Covid Kids Zone here, where materials received from children up to 12 years of age will be available on the digital archive.

These can be sent to us in a range of formats: -

- Written (poems, short stories, short anecdotes, letters, diary entries)
- Visual (art, drawings, photos)
- Multimedia (short video, podcasts, recordings)

We can accept printed material up to A4 size.
