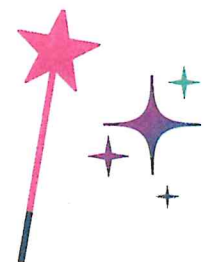
**The sooner you send back your donations, the sooner the real magic of your Trick or Treat party can start to work.**
