Ms. O'Toole will provide work for her English group each day & I will provide the work for my English group. I will provide the work for the **whole class in maths**. I would ask that parents correct the maths work each day. Thank you in advance. (Feel free to send me a picture of it too!)

The work that is written **before** the heading Ms. Rooney's English Group is work for **all of 2nd class**.

Please do send me at least 1 picture of your work each day. I look forward to hearing from you.
